From our college two students represented the camp, viz, Mr. Neeraj Shrivastav and Mr. Govind Rathod. All the students assembled at Acharya College in the morning for the registration. They had their breakfast at 9 a.m. which was continued by Inauguration by Principal Dr. Mule – Guest of Honour, NSS Coordinator. After that a lecture was given on Rights of Women in our society. After that they formed a group and gave assignment i.e. on street play. Mr. Pramod Patil provided a lecture on Right to Information which gave a boost to our youths about their rights regarding any mandatory matter. A

documentary film was shown on this matter by Mr. Milind Ranade. The day was concluded with a street play guided by Mr. Sunil Kadam.

On day second i.e. 26/01/2011 our programme started with a flag hoisting and a delicious breakfast was provided. After breakfast an awareness programme was provided in the adopted area at Ghatla, with a street play. The awareness programme was based on corruption, science, miracles, dowary system etc. the programme concluded with the discussion on assignment provided by Mr. Pramod Patil and its successful ending. NSS SPECIAL CAMP

Every year our College NSS Unit conducts a special camp residential programme. This year our NSS Unit decided to go on 16th January, 2011 & the place was Tara Village and Bhanubaichi Wadi in Panvel Taluka, Raigad district. Our team comprises of 100 NSS Volunteers, four non – NSS students with seven teachers accommodated at camp site at about 10 a.m. We had our lunch and then went to actual camp site that is at Bhanubaichi Wadi and Zilla Parishad School; we also decided what work to be done which will benefit the villagers.

We painted a Zilla Parishad School which is situated at Tara Gaon. The paint, brush and other materials was provided by our college management. We painted the entire school in four days with tree plantation at school ground premises and also provided necessary information and steps to preserve these plants. We also conducted a literacy survey in the village. The survey was about children education specially girl child and their importance given in the form of street play.

In Bhanubaichi Wadi, the villagers were mostly uneducated and unemployed; their problems were child education and employment. Here also we painted Adivasi Wadi ZP School. We also helped the school management to level the ground and tree plantation near the school.

The NSS volunteers conducted a street play in this wadi, regarding ‘Darubandi’, Women education, dowry system etc. We convey our message from these streets plays to the villagers the importance of education, disadvantages of alcohol and its impact on human health.

Our camp concluded on 22nd January, 2011 after lunch and NSS Song. The camp was dispersed at 4:00 p.m.
