

ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY 2021-22




- 2. The students were asked about the completion of syllabus prescribed by the University of Mumbai.

How much of the syllabus was covered in the class? 198 responses





4. The question was asked to students about how well the teachers could communicate with them. 64.1% were said that the teachers communicated with them always in a very effective way.


How well were the teachers able to communicate?

The institute takes active interest in the promoting internship, students exchange, field visit for students



6. The students were asked question on the teaching and mentoring process in the college. 55.6% students were of the opinion that the same very well facilitates students in cognitive, social and emotional growth.


The teaching and mentoring process in the institute facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth


- 7. The students were asked whether the institution provides with multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow 198 responses




8. The 61.1% students was of the opinion that the teachers always share the information regarding the expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcome was

Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, Course outcomes and program outcome 198 responses




9. The question was asked on the Mentor-Mentee system in the college. 54.5% students responded that there is an active Mentor-Mentee system in the college.

10. The question was asked on the teaching methodology followed by the teachers. 66.7% students said that every time teachers illustrate the concept through examples and application.


The teachers illustrate the concept through examples and application 198 responses


The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process

12. 47.5% students were strongly agree and 39.4% students were agree that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities.


Teachers encourage you to participate in extra curricular activities 198 responses

 - 54% students opined that the teachers do take such efforts to make them employable.


Efforts are made by the teachers to inculcate soft skills. life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work
