ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2021-22

1. Preparation of Academic Calendar 2021-22

The Academic Calendar for the year 2021-22 was prepared with the proposed activities to be conducted by various departments and committees. The same was uploaded on the college website.

2. Preparation and online submission of AQAR 2020-21

The AQAR criterion were submitted by the criterion in charge within the stipulated time. The IQAC verified and compiled the same for the online submission. The online AQAR for the year 2020-21 was presented before the College Development Committee meeting. The same was also uploaded on the college website.

3. Submission of CAS files for 2021-22

All the faculty members submitted CAS files for academic year 2021-22 to the IQAC except Dr. Lata Krishnan and Ms. Parveen Arif.

4. Re-application for PG Course (M.Com.)

As per the NAAC Peer Team (3rd cycle) recommendation, the college had reapplied for the PG course, M.Com. (Accountancy) to the University of Mumbai.

5. Introduction of Certificate/ Bridge/ Value Added Courses

The college conducted a 30 hours Certificate Course on Civil Defence and Yoga during 21st February, 2022 to 10th March, 2022. The objective of the course was to impart basic knowledge and training of Civil Defence and Yoga to students. Total 30 students were participated in the course.

6. Research papers publication by the faculty members

7. A One Day Multidisciplinary E-Conference On “Resilient India: The New Way Forward”

A one day multidisciplinary e-conference on “Resilient India: The New Way Forward” was organised by the IQAC in collaboration with department of Commerce on Thursday, 16th December, 2022 between 9.00 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. The conference was conducted on ZOOM platform. Total 66 teachers, research scholars and students were participated in the conference.
