

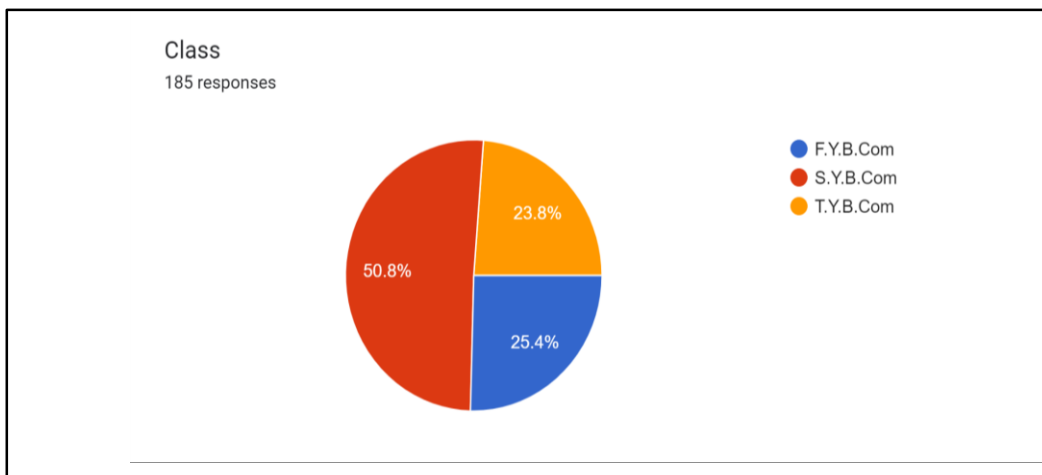

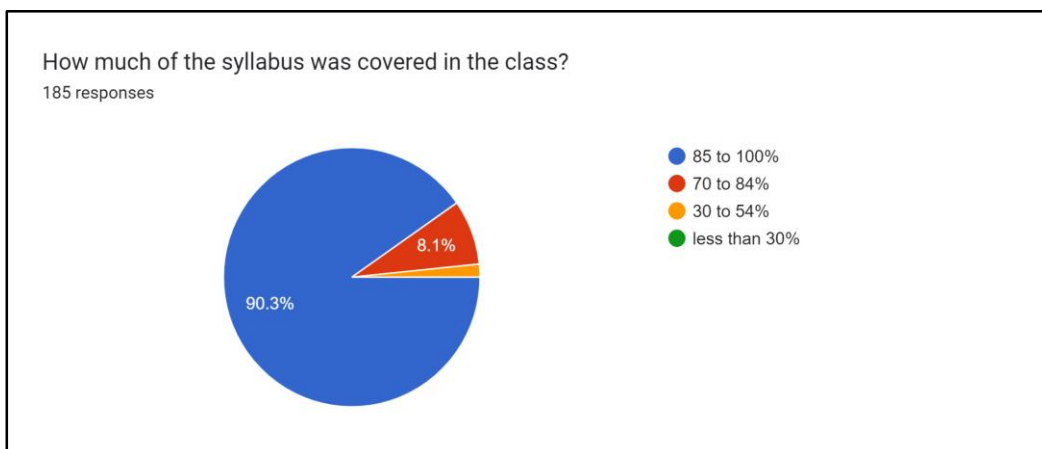

AN ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY 2022-23

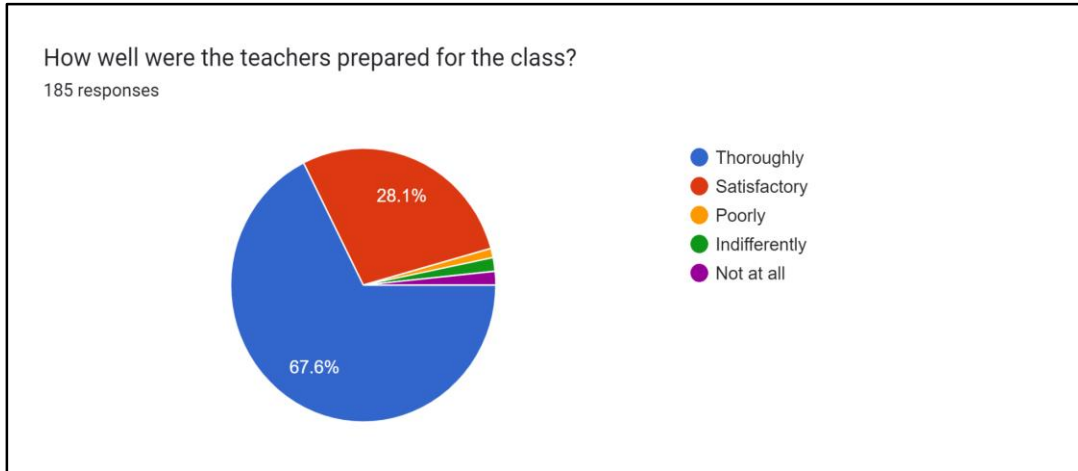

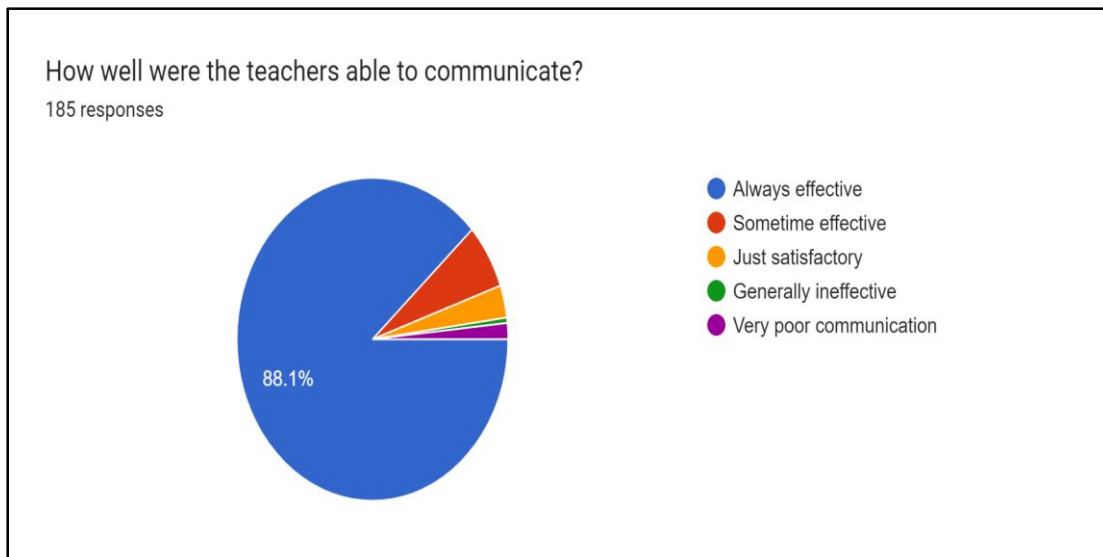
- The students were asked their responses on the completion of syllabus. Out of total responses 167 students responded that syllabus was completed up to 85% to 100% by teachers.



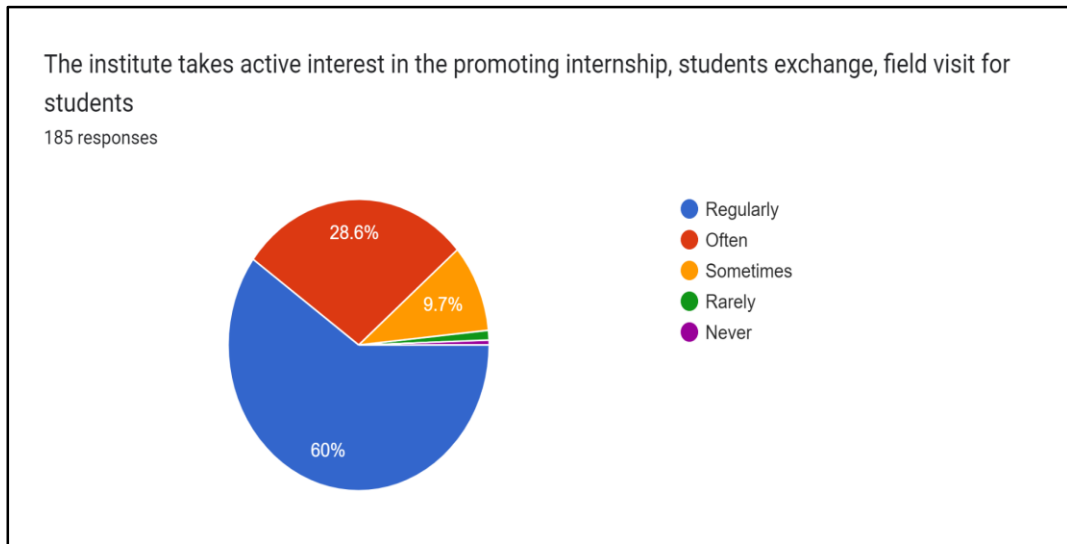
- The students were asked about the teachers' preparation for the lectures. 125 students were of the opinion that teachers prepare thoroughly for their lectures.



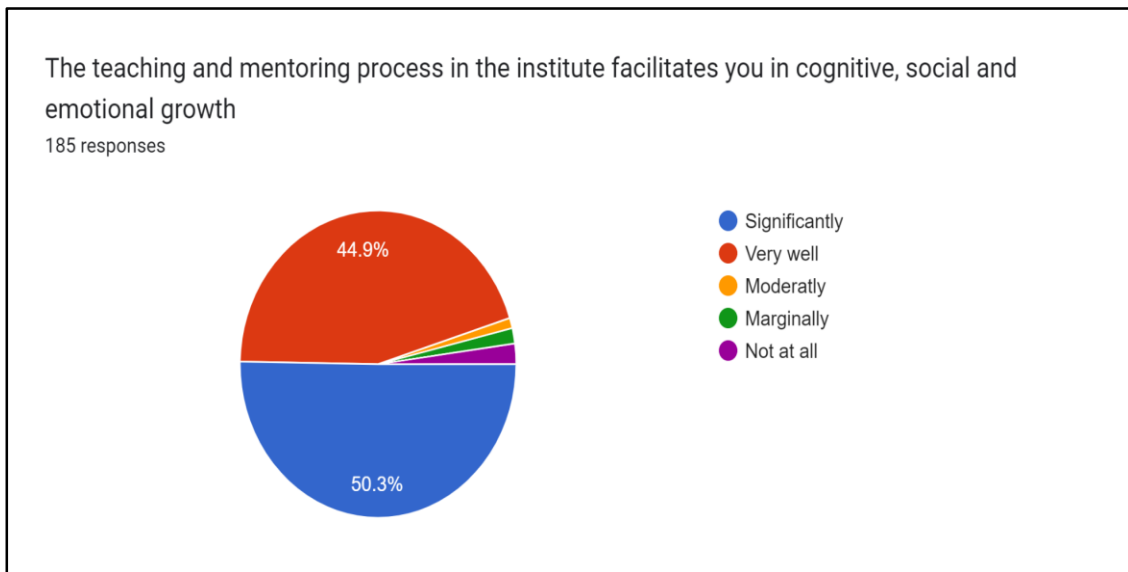
- The students were asked how well the teachers are able to communicate with them during the lecture. 163 students responded that the teachers always communicate effectively during the lectures.



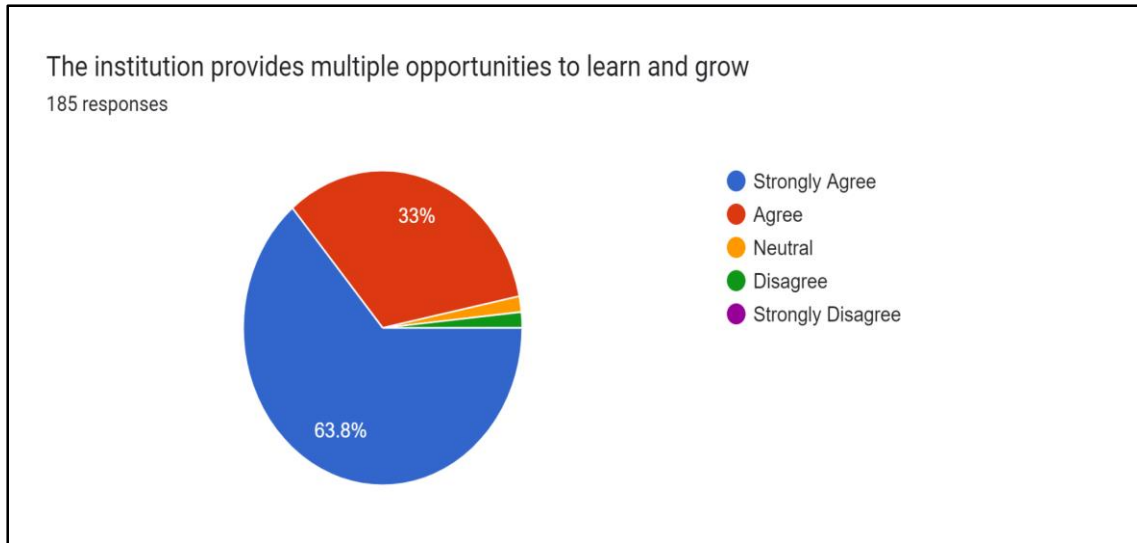
- The question was asked about the institute’s initiatives in promoting internship, students exchange, field visit for students. 111 students said that the institution always takes an active interest in the above-mentioned areas.



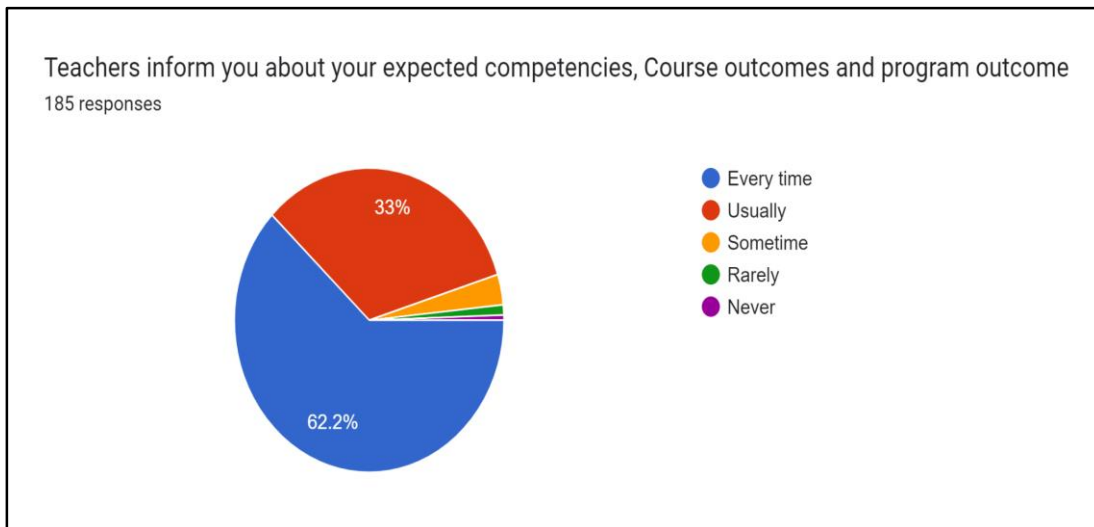

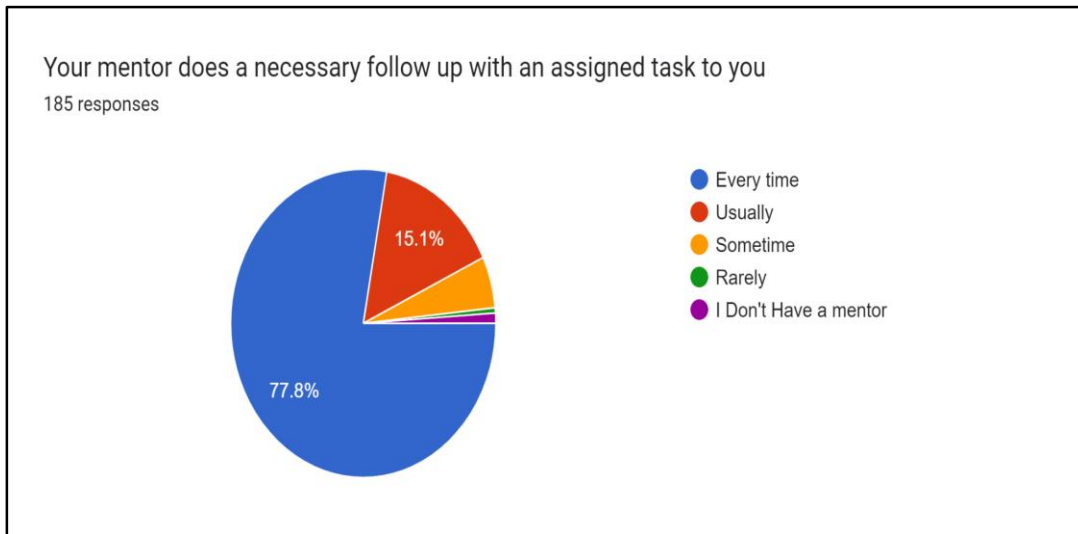
- The question was asked about the opportunities provided by the institute to learn and grow. 118 students strongly agreed on the same.



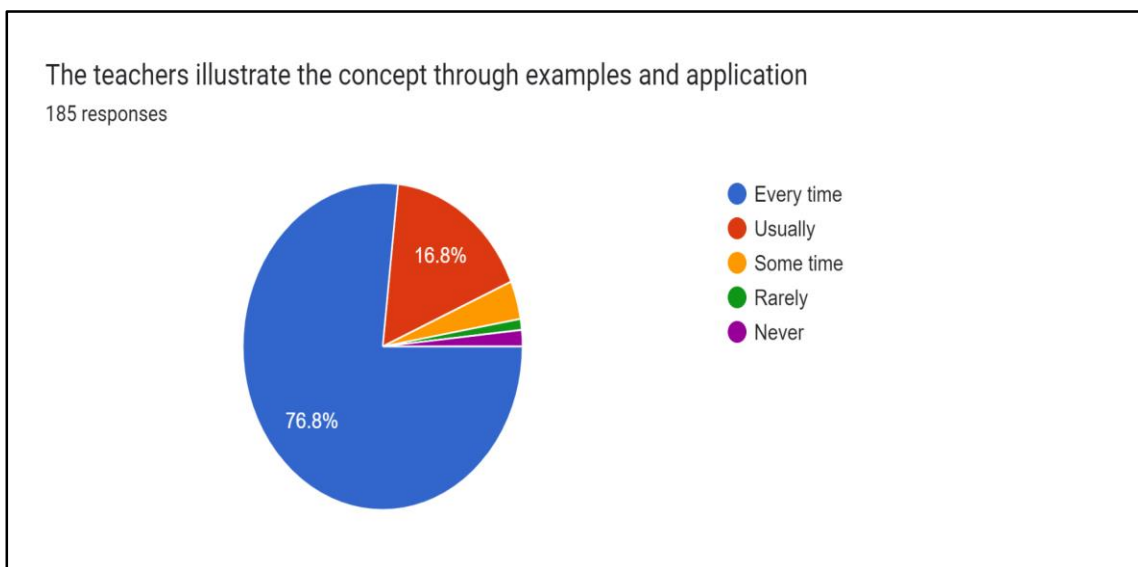
- The students were asked whether teachers inform them about their expected competencies, Course outcomes and program outcomes. 115 students responded that every time they are informed about the same.



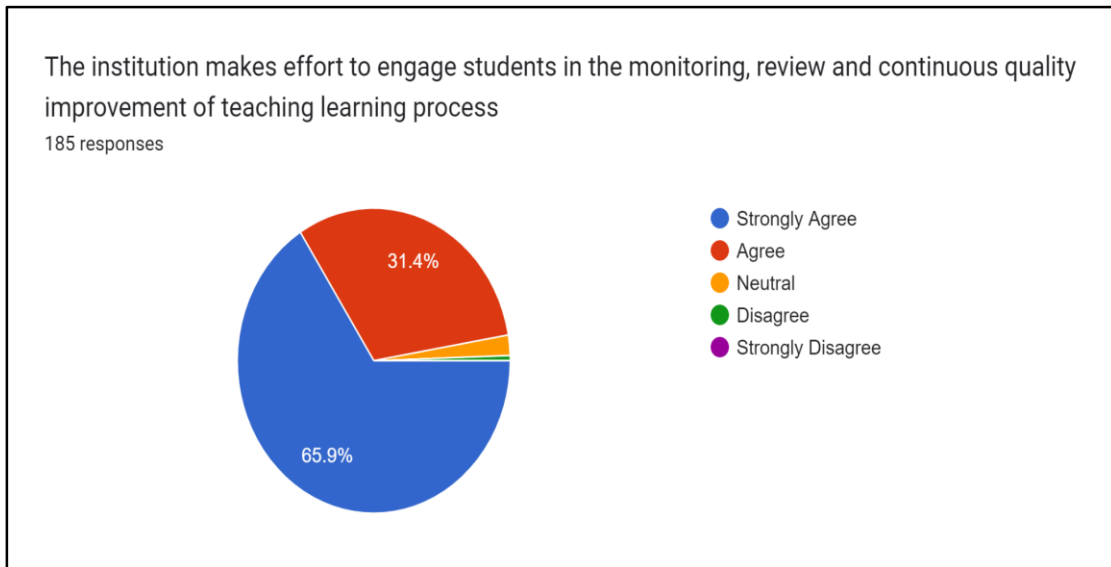

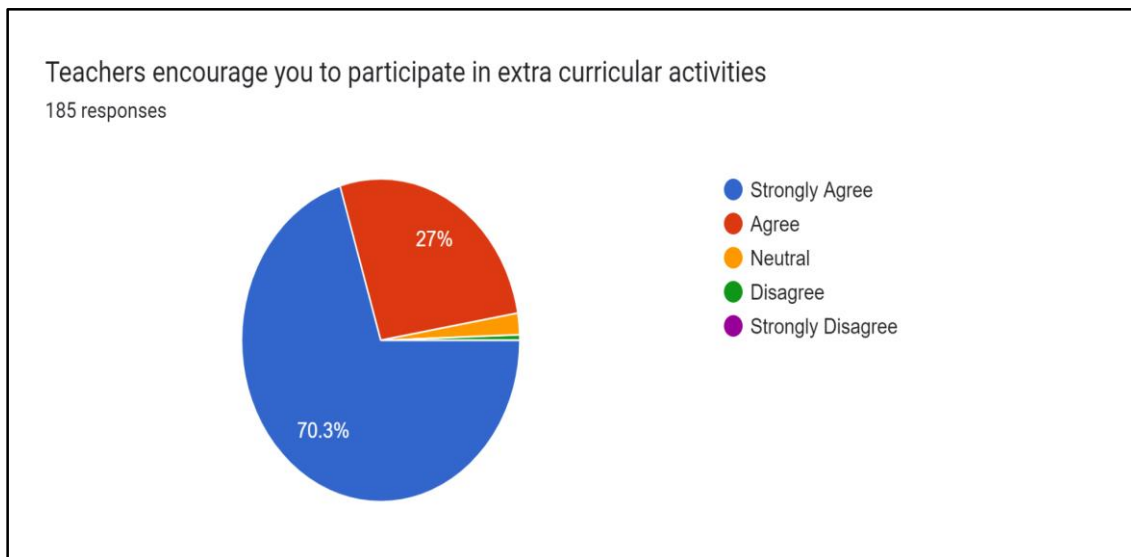
- The question was asked about the teaching methodology of the teachers during the lecture. 142 students were of the opinion that teachers always illustrate the concept through examples and application.



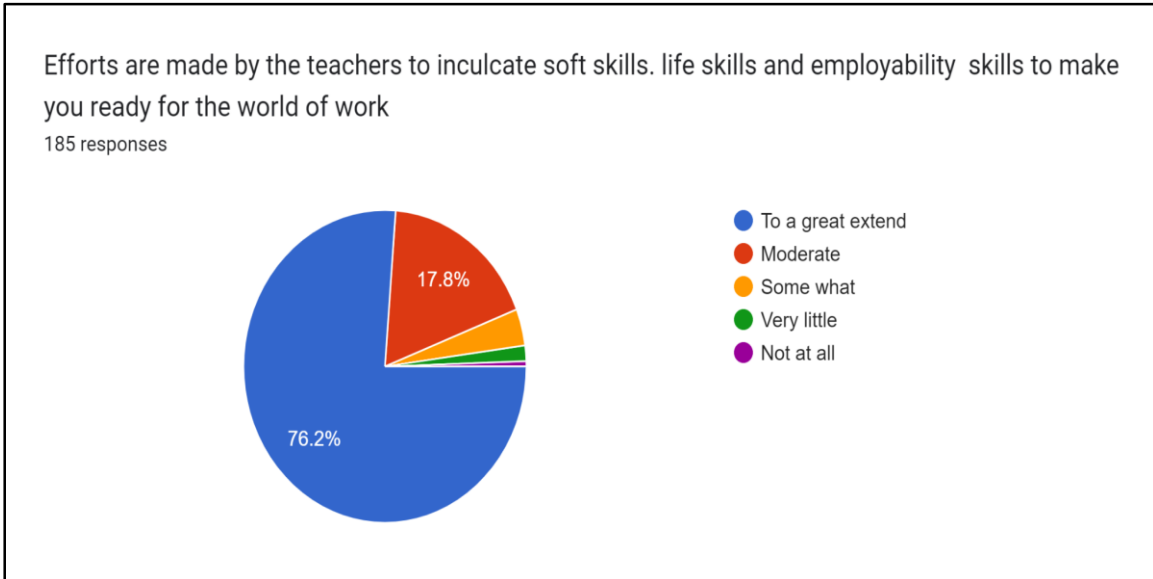

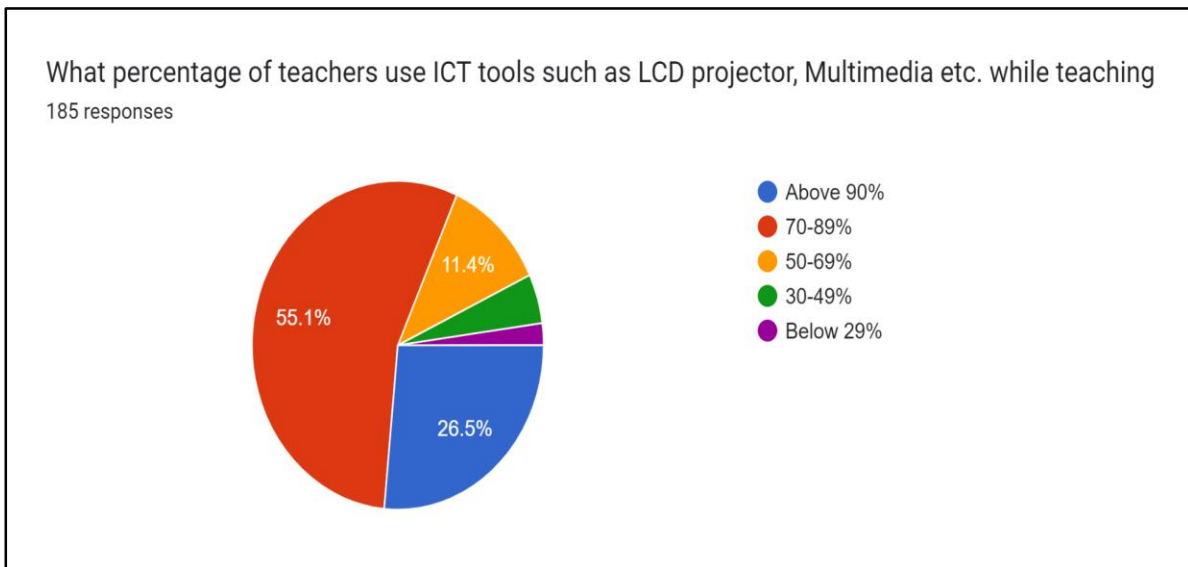
- The students were asked whether they are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities. 130 students strongly agree that teachers encourage them to participate in the same.



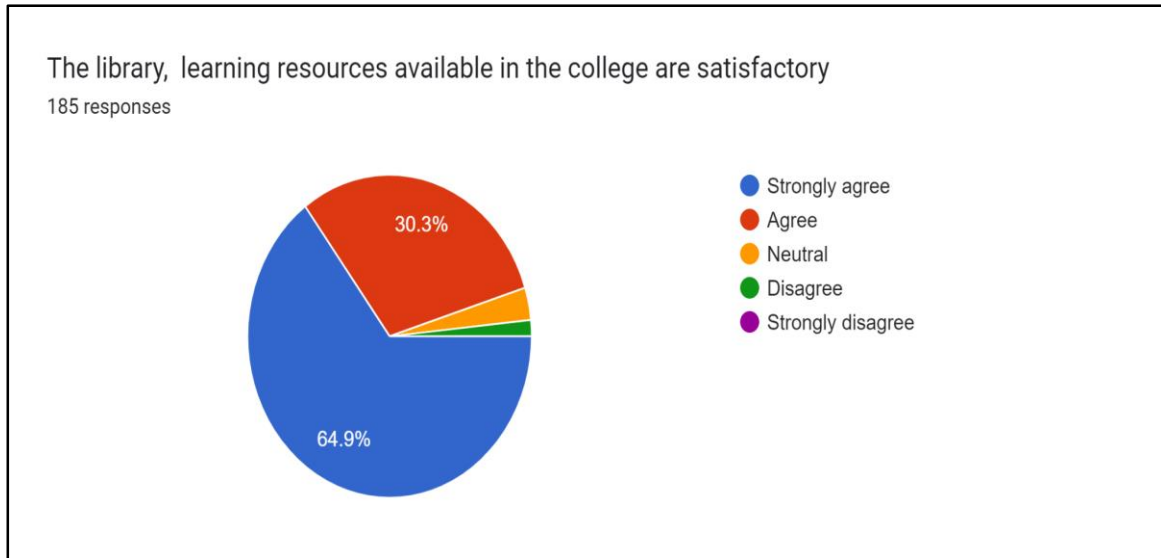

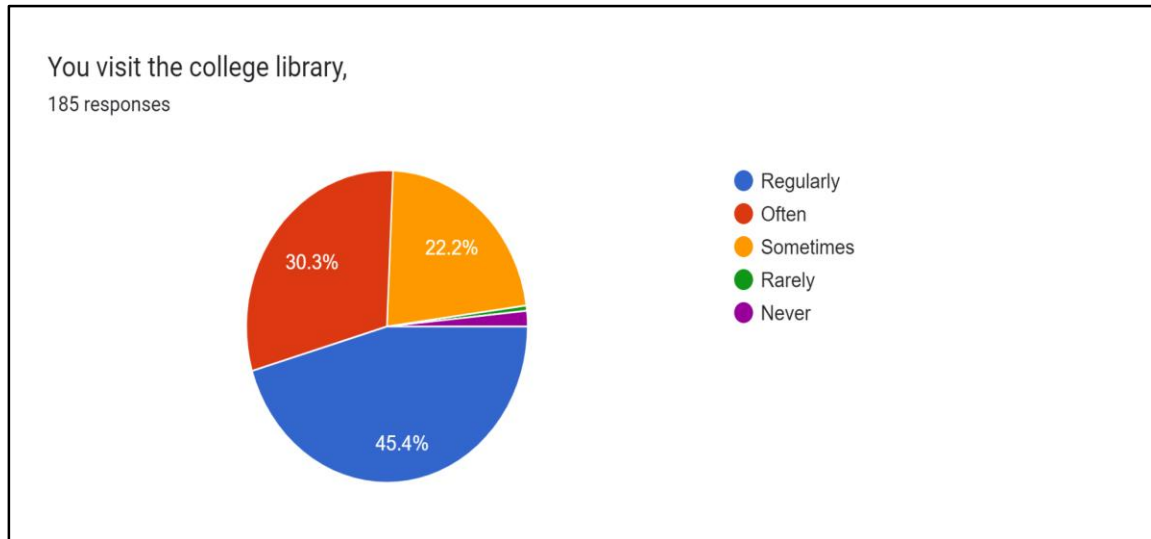
- The question was asked on the use of ICT tools by teachers. 102 students answered that the teachers use ICT tools to the extent of 70% to 89% while teaching.



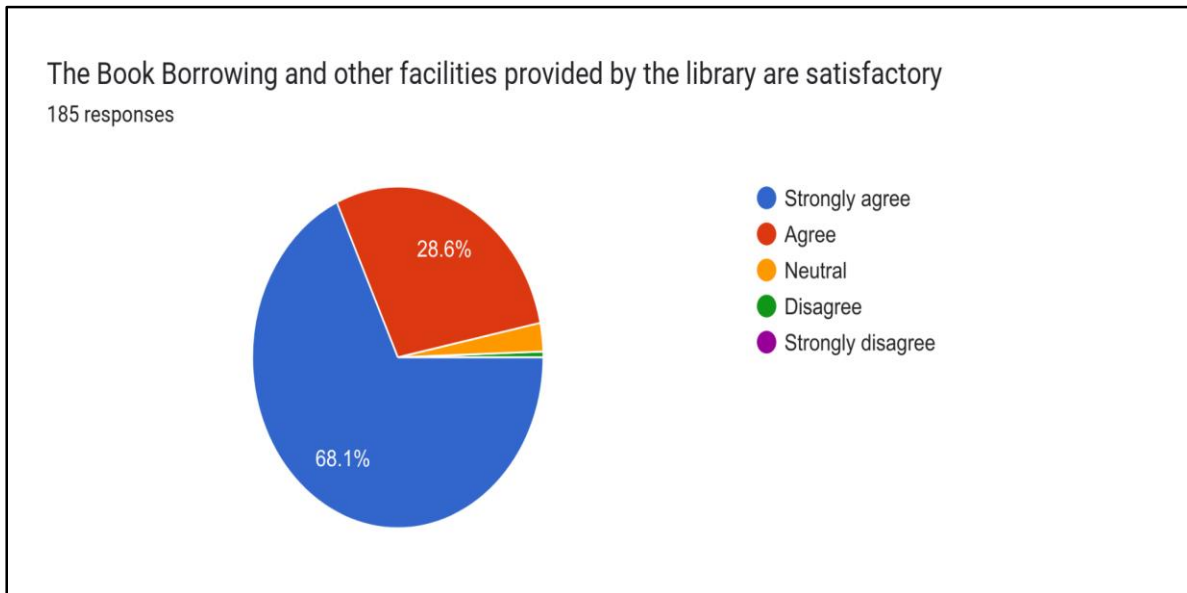
- The question was asked about the learning resources available in the institute. 176 students were satisfied with the library, learning resources in the institute.
