

A Report submitted by the Trainer Ms. Saranga Kamble about the CareeReady Programme, Organization and modules completed with students of F.Y.B.Com and S.Y.B.Com of Mahatma Night Degree College of Arts and Commerce, Chembur

Brief introduction about the organization:

Antarang Foundation is an organization that bridges the gap between Education and Employability for youth. Through our structured programs, Antarang guides youth on Career choice trains them in core Employability Skills, connects them to Employment opportunities of their choice and continues to Mentor them through a network of mentors until they integrate well into careers of their choice.

Over the past 4 years, Antarang has worked with ~25000 young adults across ~ 60-night schools, ~ 25-day schools, through 19 community-based career service centers and 5 senior colleges across Mumbai in the core areas of Career Guidance and Work Readiness with youth.

We have been affiliated with and conducted several batches of our CareeReady Employability Skills Program at P.N. Doshi college - Ghatkopar, MMP Shah college - Matunga, MD college - Parel, Gurunanak college - GTB and MD Shah Mahila college - Malad, IY College - Jogeshwari and more other colleges.


Careeready Program:

This program covers:

- 1) Self Awareness activities - this measure the students' Interests, Aptitude, Personality, Realities, Aspirations, Support Systems
- 2) Career Awareness - detailed information on 8-10 popular Career choices are given and students' Fitment is assessed
- 3) Work Skills and Work Ethics - grooming, personal presentation, communication, stress & anger management, interview readiness, and essential employability work ethics
- 4) Career Linkages - education (mainstream / vocational) and career linkages (part time / full time / internships) are made
- 5) Mentor connect - connect with a Mentor (a corporate volunteer) who guides students as they take their first career steps

This 40 sessions of classroom intervention build skills of collaboration, communication, critical thinking, creativity, commercial skills, and computer literacy along with the all-important work-ethics help young adults acknowledge the value of reliability, integrity, and initiative.

CareeReady integrates plenty of industry exposure and results in building the ability to make informed medium career choices.

What have we covered so far for Mahatma Night College (MNCM1) :

1. Self- awareness activities- We have covered all the self -awareness activities for all the students of Mahatma night college
2. Career awareness- 11 career groups covered which in total led to around 30+ professions. Students then had a list of careers which match their self -awareness module. From that they picked up one career and we made a detailed career plan for the same. They are in the process of doing a project and presentation on their chosen career.
3. Work ethics and work skills- All work ethics and work skills covered. The average percentage of students following work ethics is around 80%. Students still have to work on their punctuality and regularity
4. Business English- They are encouraged to speak in English in class and we use Duo-lingo app for learning English along with sessions in class.
5. Placement, Alumni engagement and Mentor connect will be provided after their moc interviews. Mocs are scheduled on 15th March 2019

'CAREEREADY' PROGRAMME FOR S.Y.B.COM. STUDENTS OF MAHATMA NIGHT DEGREE COLLEGE – A MNDC PLACEMENT CELL INITIATIVE (JANUARY 2019)

The Placement Cell of Mahatma Night Degree College of Arts and Commerce, Chembur spear headed by the Principal of the college Principal Dr. Padma Rangan have set the ball rolling for the 'CareeReady Programme' organized by Antarang Foundation 231-C, Tawripada, Dr. S.S. Rao Road, Lalbaug, Parel, Mumbai 400 012, for the S.Y.B.Com. students of Mahatma Night Degree College of Arts and Commerce. This programme will begin in January, 2019. Antarang Foundation works to bridge the Employability gap that exists amongst disadvantaged youth.

The second orientation programme for Antarang Foundation's 'CarreReady' was conducted on Thursday, 13th December, 2018 at 7.00 p.m. for the F.Y.B.Com. and S.Y.B.Com. students in room number 404. Mentoring and hand holding to help the students establish themselves in their careers is the objective of Antarang Foundation. 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

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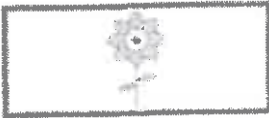

He was honored with a medal recognizing his act as an Active Citizen in the CMCA's Annual programme Inspiration on 4th August, 2018 in Birla Matoshree Hall, Marine Lines.

CMCA has stepped into the 18th year of its success. CMCA's annual event 'Inspiration 2018' was organized on Saturday, 4th August, 2018 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Birla Matushri Hall, Marine Lines, Mumbai.



Mahatma Night Degree college students participated in the programme. Ten students from T.Y.B.Com. were accompanied by Associate Professor and H.O.D. of Commerce Dr. Lata Krishnan and CMCA Life Skills Tutor Ms. Brinda Ganesh to reach the venue at 9.00 a.m. sharp to get ready for the flag march.

The gathering comprised of school and college students who presented skits, songs and speeches showcasing the initiatives they had taken during the year to solve problems they faced in the society around them. The event included a Flag March and an Oath taking ceremony on the stage, by all the children representing their schools and colleges with their respective school flags.

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The Chief Guest for the event was Afroz Shah (About the Chief Guest) Afroz Shah, a young Indian lawyer from Mumbai, is synonymous with the world's largest beach clean-up project.

In October 2015, Shah and his neighbor Harbansh Mathur, an 84-year-old who has since passed away, were frustrated with the piles of decomposing waste that had washed up and completely overwhelmed the city's Versova beach. Determined to do something about it, the pair started cleaning up the beach themselves, one piece of rubbish at a time.

Every weekend since, Shah has inspired volunteers to join him – from slum-dwellers to Bollywood stars, from schoolchildren to politicians. They have been turning up at Versova for what Shah calls “a date with the ocean”, but what in reality means labouring shin-deep in rotting garbage under the scorching Indian sun.

So far, the volunteers have collected over 4,000 tons of trash from the 2.5 kilometre beach.

Shah, who rallied residents and fisherfolk by knocking on doors and explaining the damage marine litter causes, now plans to expand his group's operation to prevent litter from washing down the local creek and onto the beach. He also wants to clean-up the coastline's rubbish-choked mangrove forests, which act as a natural defence against storm surges, and to inspire similar groups across India and beyond to launch their own clean-up movements.

Shah is deservedly proud of the Versova residents' accomplishments. Not only has the movement brought marine litter to the attention of decision-makers, it is also starting to win back the beach, with decreasing amounts of new litter appearing each month.

He vows to continue his beach clean-up crusade until people and their governments around the world change their approach to producing, using and discarding plastic and other products that wash up onto beaches all over the world.

The Chief Guest Afroz Shah spoke affectionately to all the students and through his narratives inspired the audience to join him in the good work he is doing. He had a spark in his eye and said that he saw the same spark in the eyes of the young active citizens gathered in the hall.

After the skits, songs and speeches ten active citizens across schools and colleges in Mumbai were recognized for their acts of active citizenship. Medals were given to these students by the Chief Guest Afroz Shah. It was a moment of glory for the students, teachers, schools, colleges and parents who had gathered there to see the award ceremony. The narrator began with stating the real story where four young men from another state living in Maharashtra, working in Maharashtra visited the police station to give the officers some personal details about themselves as this was a requirement for their job. The police officers received the young men well, spoke to them respectfully and the formalities were completed. The four young men had to leave Maharashtra and go back to their home town in another state to attend a family wedding. They were away for a month. This was the true story.

A news reporter looking for a juicy story reports it like this – Four young men from another state, working in Maharashtra were held up by the police for questioning. The boys have absconded since then. The police are looking for them as they are involved in a criminal case.

A Municipal Corporater visited a housing society to address them before the local elections. In his talk he narrated the story stating that many young boys from outside states are roaming around the city. They work in the city and live on rent in housing societies. These boys are anti-social elements and criminals. The Corporater warned the society members not to allow boys from different states to enter the society. He asked them to be careful and vigilant about such instances. He wanted to protect members from such criminals.

Being the first in the Workshop series of Campus Yuva, after a brief introduction, students were made aware of the consequences of spreading news through a Role play and the dangers of fake news. They were made to think critically and analyse through tests if any piece of information was received or even when connecting to everyday life.

That it is our fundamental duty to develop social scientific temper and a spirit of inquiry and reform formed the conclusion of the workshop.

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A member from the housing society hearing this speech immediately sends a WhatsApp message to his friends in different housing societies announcing the arrival of criminal young boys from outside states living on rent in housing societies, posing to work in offices in Mumbai. Do not let them enter your society! These boys are criminals. **BEWARE BOYS FROM OUTSIDE STATES THEY ARE CRIMINALS.**

The students in the class were told the real story by the narrator. The group standing outside did not hear the true story. They were called in when the other members performed their part as the news reporter, Municipal Corporater and Member from the housing society. On listening to them the group that entered the class were asked to form their opinion on what had actually happened. They were influenced by the three stories they heard and believed that there were young boys from an outside state who were criminals.

The entire class listened in pin drop silence and appreciated the gap between reality and what was reported **FROM DIFFERENT SOURCES** in every instance. The students were called up one by one and asked to comment on what they understood. They explained that each of the characters in the case had twisted the facts to serve their own purpose. The news reports wanted a juicy story, the Municipal Corporater wanted votes and the member of the housing society wanted to connect with his friends with an interesting message. **NONE** of the stories were true.

The workshop concluded. The objective of the workshop to understand the importance of **SCIENTIFIC TEMPER** was achieved. Students realised that Reasoning and questioning the source of information is very important. Do not believe blindly what you hear and see. Find out the source of the information and question its authenticity before you believe anything you hear.

This was the message given to the students in the workshop.

Samadhi - salvation - State of super bliss, joy and merging individual consciousness into universal consciousness. Union between Jivatma and Paramataman. Why Revision?

There is a Rapid expansion of knowledge in subject matter areas and improved instructional method during last decade. There are considerable curricular revisions happening at the high school level. Application of Mathematics and Statistics are widely used in industry and business. Keeping this in mind, a revision of syllabus required in accordance with the growth of subject of at the high school level and emerging needs of industry and its application.

Objective:

The main objective of this course is to introduce mathematics and statistics to undergraduate students of commerce, so that they can use them in the field of commerce and industry to solve the real life problems.

Distribution of topics and lectures

Mathematical and Statistical Techniques-I

[A] MATHEMATICS: (40 marks)

Unit I: Shares and Mutual Funds

- Shares:** Concept of share, face value, market value, dividend, equity shares, preferential shares, bonus shares. Simple examples.
- Mutual Funds:** Simple problems on calculation of Net income after considering entry load, dividend, change in Net Asset Value (N.A.V.) and exit load. Averaging of price under the Systematic Investment Plan (S.I.P.)

Unit II: Permutation, Combination and Linear Programming Problems:

- Permutation and Combination:** Factorial Notation, Fundamental principle of counting, Permutation as arrangement, Simple examples, combination as selection, Simple examples, Relation between ${}^n C_r$ and ${}^n P_r$, Examples on commercial application of permutation and combination.
- Linear Programming Problem:** Sketching of graphs of (i) linear equation $Ax + By + C = 0$ (ii) linear inequalities. Mathematical Formulation of Linear Programming Problems upto 3 variables. Solution of Linear Programming Problems using graphical method up to two variables.

[B] STATISTICS: (60 marks)

Unit III: Summarization Measures:

- Measures of Central Tendencies:** Definition of Average, Types of Averages: Arithmetic Mean, Median, and Mode for grouped as well as ungrouped data. Quartiles, Deciles and Percentiles. Using Ogive locate median and Quartiles. Using Histogram locate mode. Combined and Weighted mean.
- Measures of Dispersions:** Concept and idea of dispersion. Various measures Range, Quartile Deviation, Mean Deviation, Standard Deviation, Variance, Combined Variance.

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Unit IV: Elementary Probability Theory:

- a. **Probability Theory:** Concept of random experiment/trial and possible outcomes; Sample Space and Discrete Sample Space; Events their types, Algebra of Events, Mutually Exclusive and Exhaustive Events, Complimentary events.
Classical definition of Probability, Addition theorem (without proof), conditional probability.
Independence of Events: $P(A \cap B) = P(A)P(B)$. Simple examples.
- b. **Random Variable:** Probability distribution of a discrete random variable; Expectation and Variance of random variable, simple examples on probability distributions.

Unit V: Decision Theory:

Decision making situation, Decision maker, Courses of Action, States of Nature, Pay-off and Pay-off matrix; Decision making under uncertainty, Maximin, Maximax, Minimax regret and Laplace criteria; simple examples to find optimum decision. Formulation of Payoff Matrix. Decision making under Risk, Expected Monetary Value (EMV); Decision Tree; Simple Examples based on EMV. Expected Opportunity Loss (EOL), simple examples based on EOL.

[A] MATHEMATICS : (40 marks)

Unit I : Functions, Derivatives and Their Applications

- a. **Concept of real functions:** constant function, linear function, x^n , e^x , a^x , $\log x$.
Demand, Supply, Total Revenue, Average Revenue, Total cost, Average cost and Profit function. Equilibrium Point, Break-even point.
- b. **Derivative of functions:**
 - i. Derivative as rate measure, Derivative of x^n , e^x , a^x , $\log x$.
 - ii. Rules of derivatives: Scalar multiplication, sum, difference, product, quotient (Statements only), Simple problems. Second order derivatives.
 - iii. Applications: Marginal Cost, Marginal Revenue, Elasticity of Demand. Maxima and Minima for functions in Economics and Commerce.
(Examination Questions on this unit should be application oriented only.)

Unit II: Interest and Annuity:

- a. **Interest:** Simple Interest, Compound Interest (Nominal & Effective Rate of Interest), Calculations involving upto 4 time periods.
- b. **Annuity:** Annuity Immediate and its Present value, Future value. Equated Monthly Installments (EMI) using reducing balance method & amortization of loans. Stated Annual Rate & Affective Annual Rate Perpetuity and its present value. Simple problems involving up to 4 time periods.

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[B] STATISTICS: (60 marks)

Unit III: Bivariate Linear Correlation and Regression

- a. **Correlation Analysis:** Meaning, Types of Correlation, Determination of Correlation: Scatter diagram, Karl Pearson's method of Correlation Coefficient (excluding Bivariate Frequency Distribution Table) and Spearman's Rank Correlation Coefficient.
- b. **Regression Analysis:** Meaning, Concept of Regression equations, Slope of the Regression Line and its interpretation. Regression Coefficients (excluding Bivariate Frequency Distribution Table), Relationship between Coefficient of Correlation and Regression Coefficients, Finding the equations of Regression lines by method of Least Squares.

Unit IV : Time series and Index Numbers

- a. **Time series:** Concepts and components of a time series. Representation of trend by Freehand Curve Method, Estimation of Trend using Moving Average Method and Least Squares Method (Linear Trend only). Estimation of Seasonal Component using Simple Arithmetic Mean for Additive Model only (For Trend free data only). Concept of Forecasting using Least Squares Method.
- b. **Index Numbers:** Concept and usage of Index numbers, Types of Index numbers, Aggregate and Relative Index Numbers, Lasperye's, Paasche's, Dorbisch-Bowley's, Marshall-Edgeworth and Fisher's ideal index numbers, Test of Consistency: Time Reversal Test and Factor Reversal Test. Chain Base Index Nos. Shifting of Base year. Cost of Living Index Numbers, Concept of Real Income, Concept of Wholesale Price Index Number. (Examples on missing values should not be taken)

Unit V: Elementary Probability Distributions

Probability Distributions:

- i. Discrete Probability Distribution: Binomial, Poisson (Properties and applications only, no derivations are expected)
- ii. Continuous Probability distribution: Normal Distribution. (Properties and applications only, no derivations are expected)

Tutorial:

Two tutorials to be conducted on each unit i.e. 10 tutorials per semester. At the end of each semester one Tutorial assignment of 10 marks should be given.

Examination:

Semester End Examination: 100 marks

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At the end of each semester, there will be a Semester End Examination of 100 marks, 3 hours duration and question paper pattern as shown below.

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
