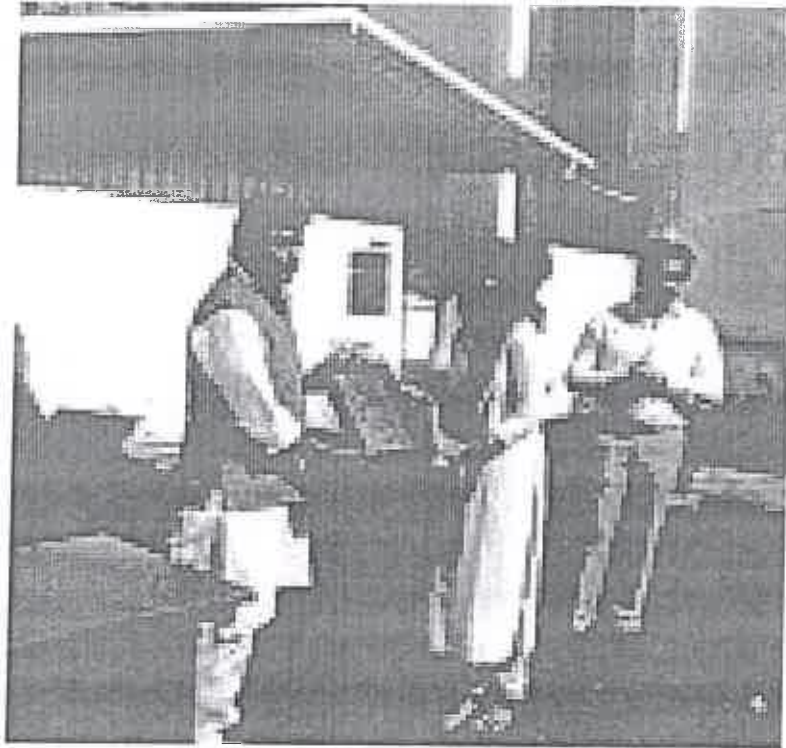
Essay Competition on "Lokshahi Ani Me"

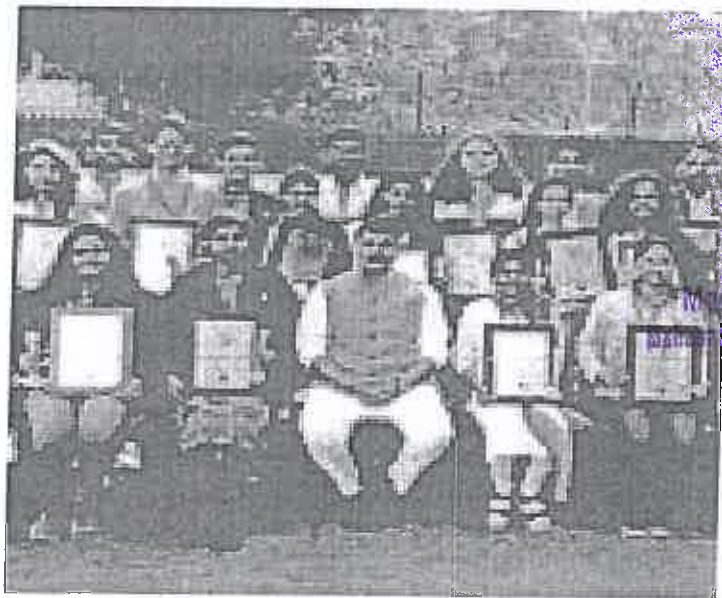

Brief Report of the Program-:Prarambh is an annual inter-collegiate cultural fest organized by Mahatma Night Degree College of Arts and Commerce. It was planned that only 4 events can be organized in a streamlined manner. Therefore, participants were asked to submit the videos of not more than 3 minutes of their solo song, dance, and elocution's along with google form. Poster-making competition participants were asked to upload their poster along with google forms. To ensure the authenticity of participants, all of them were asked to upload their scanned identity cards with the google form. The Prarambh event received a good response for all categories as 70 participants participated under the various categories.

The program started sharp at 11 a.m. on 15th March 2021. Dr. Lata Krishnan, Dr. Ananya Markandeya and Asst.Prof. Tushar Pawar were the judges for the all events. 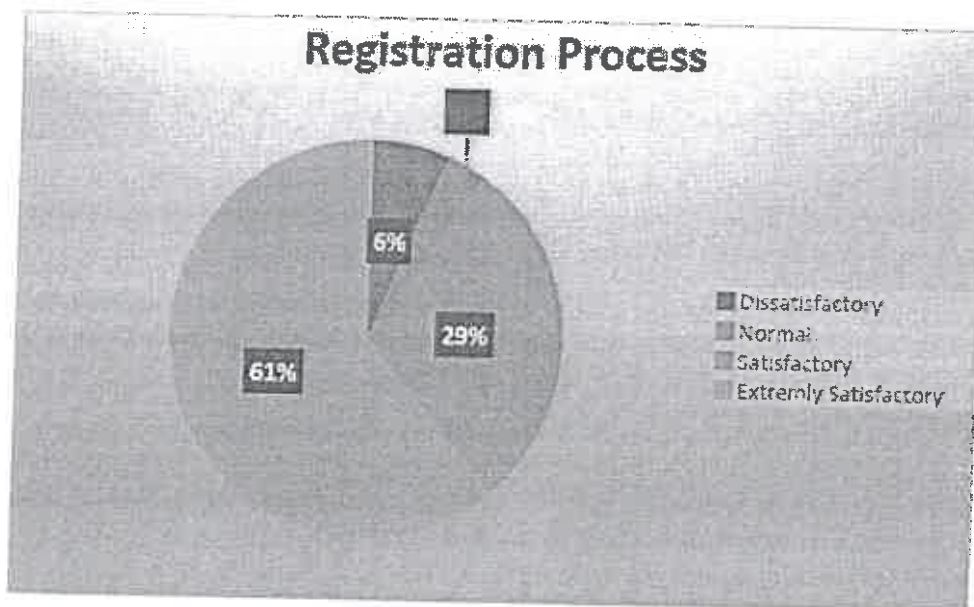
Feed Back Form Analysis Prarambh -An Inter-Collegiate Cultural Fest 2020-21."

Figure 1: Registration Process



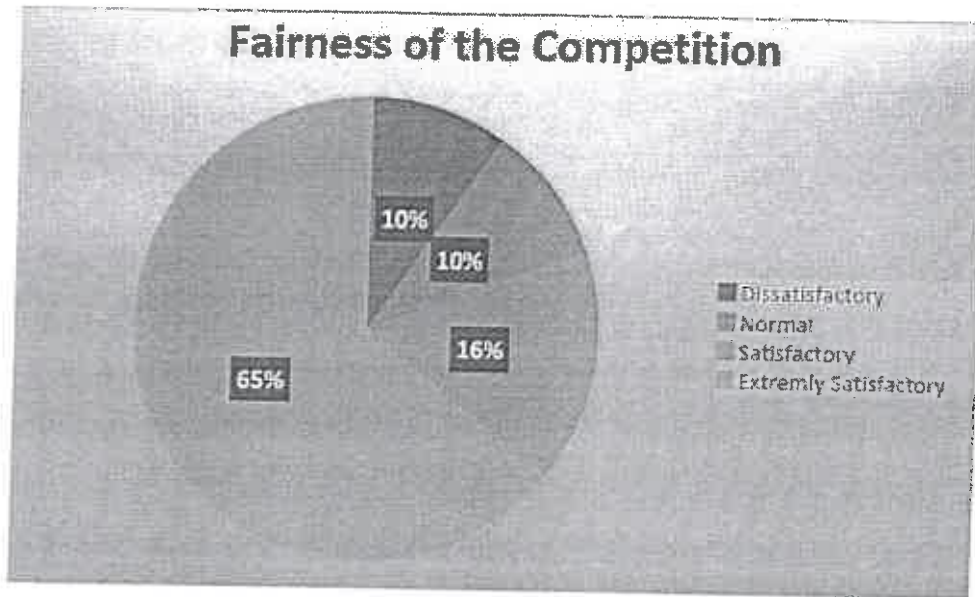

Figure 2: Fairness of the competition

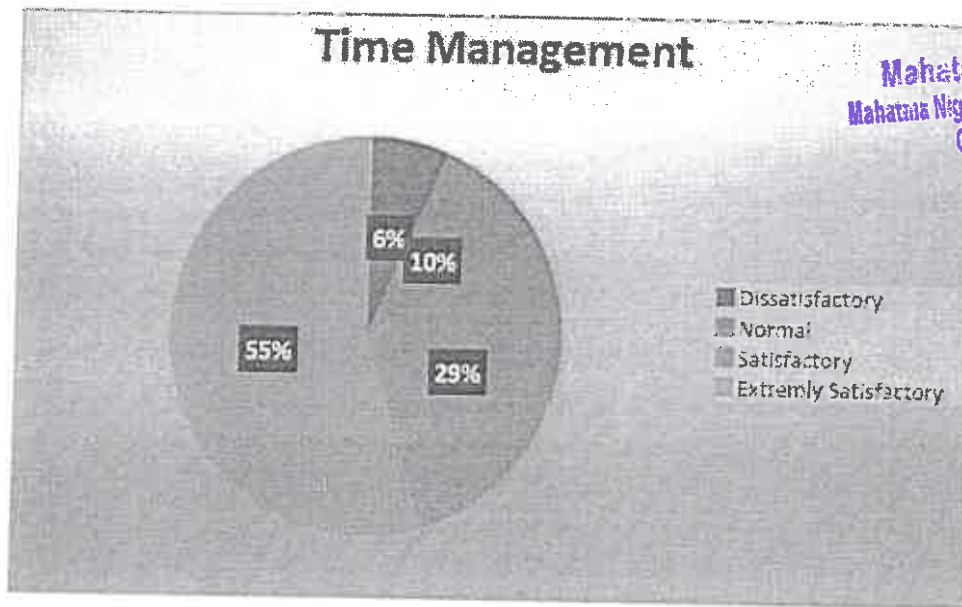

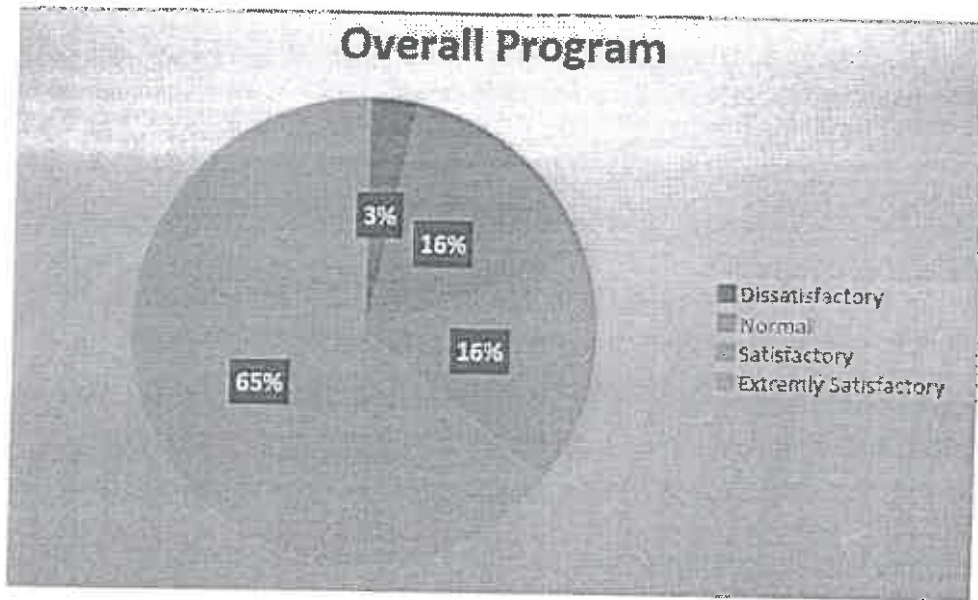

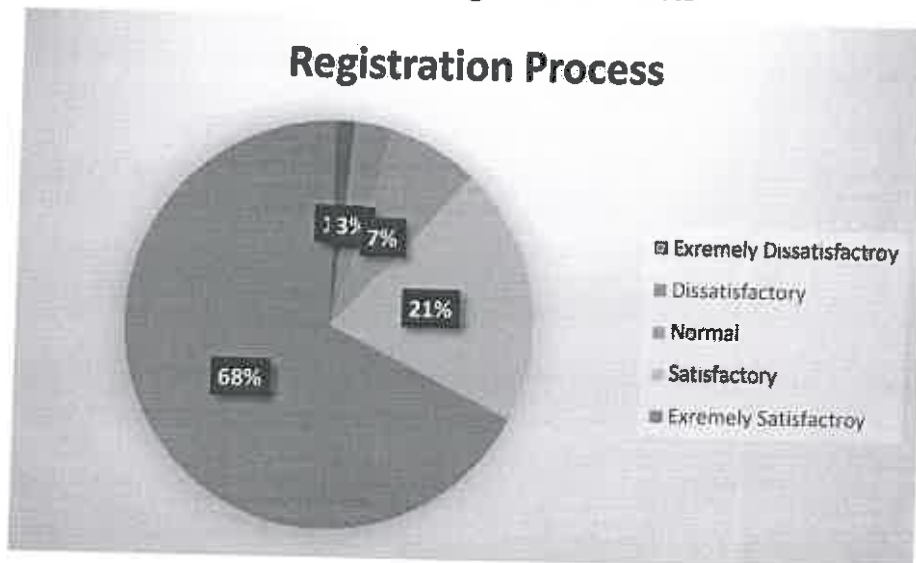

Figure 1: Registration Process

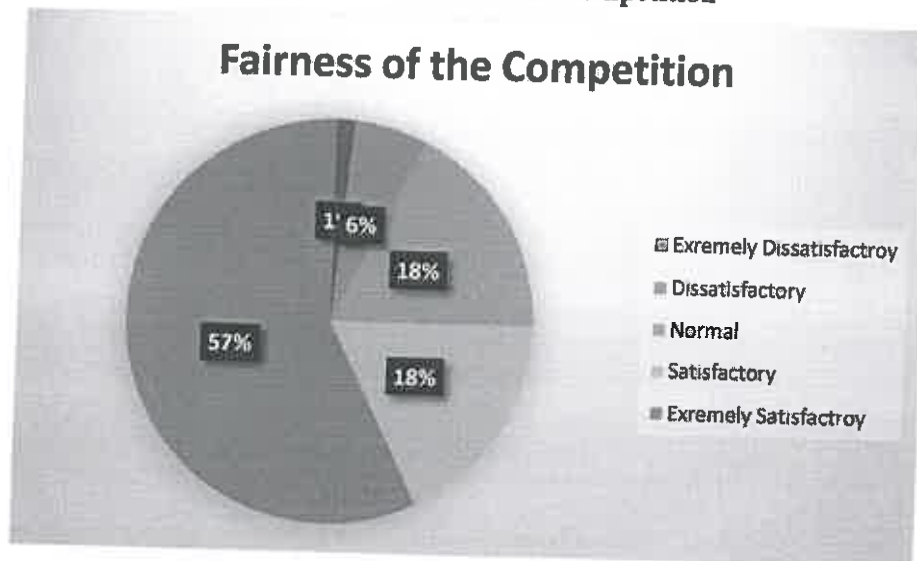

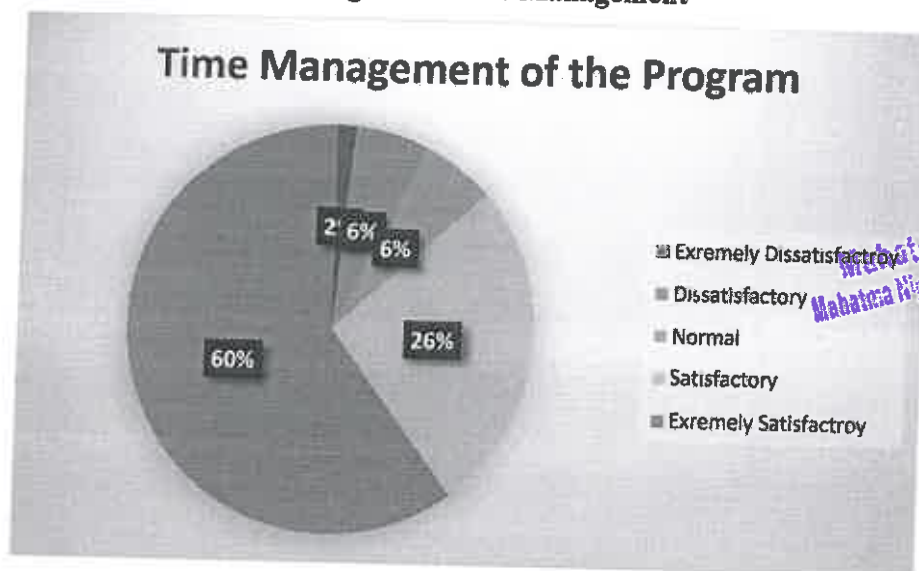
Figure 2: Fairness of the competition

Figure 3: Time Management



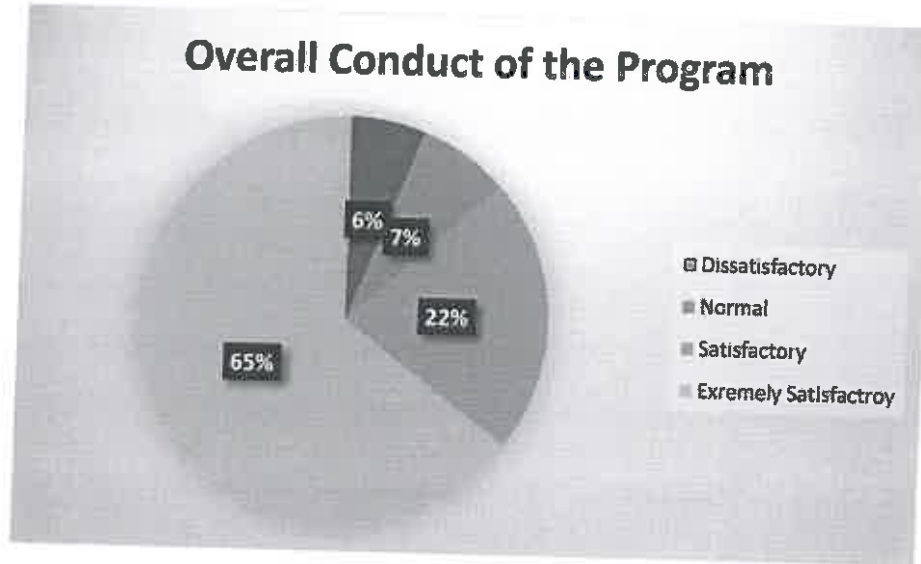
