Report on Community Service Day 2019-20

Introduction

Objective

About Activity

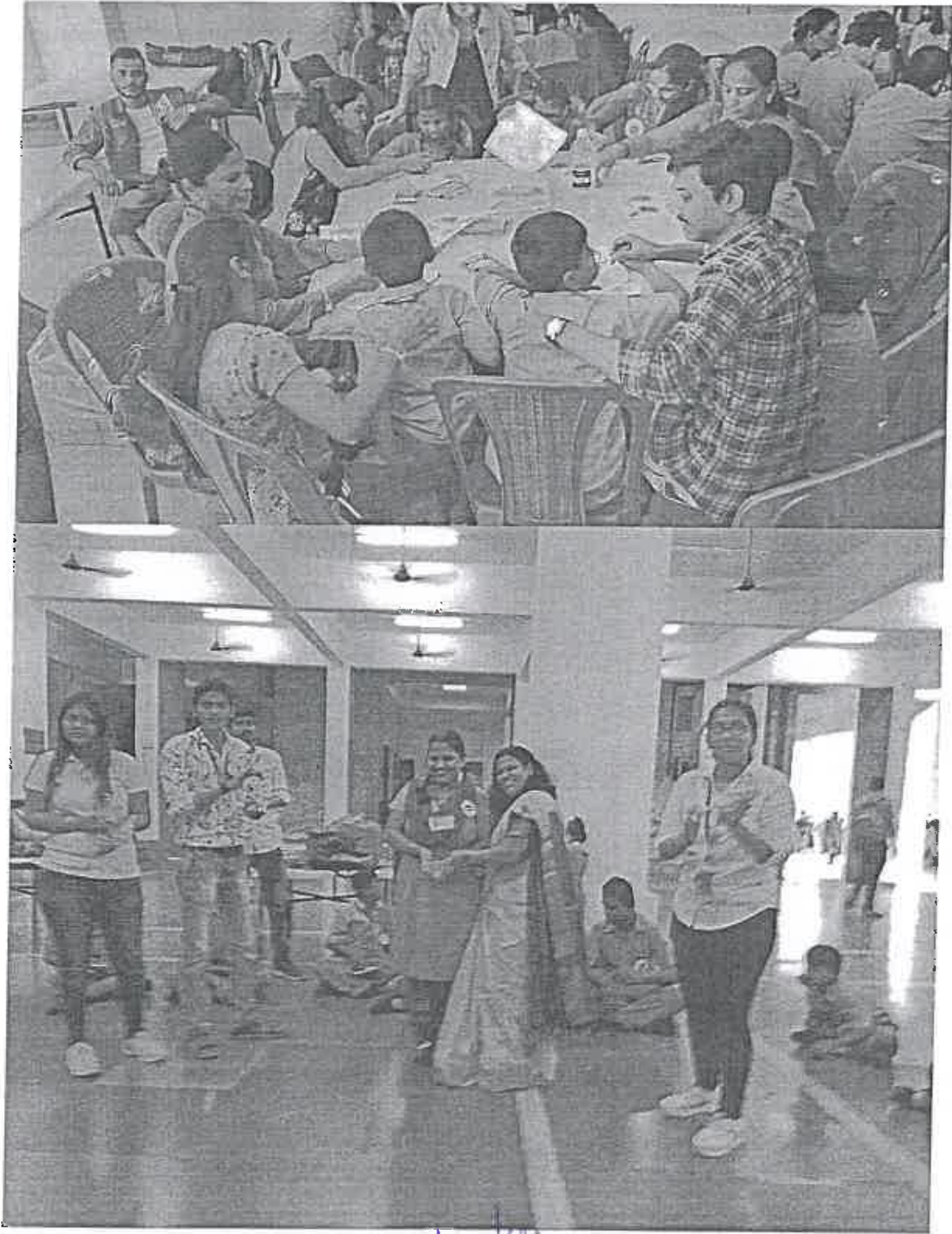

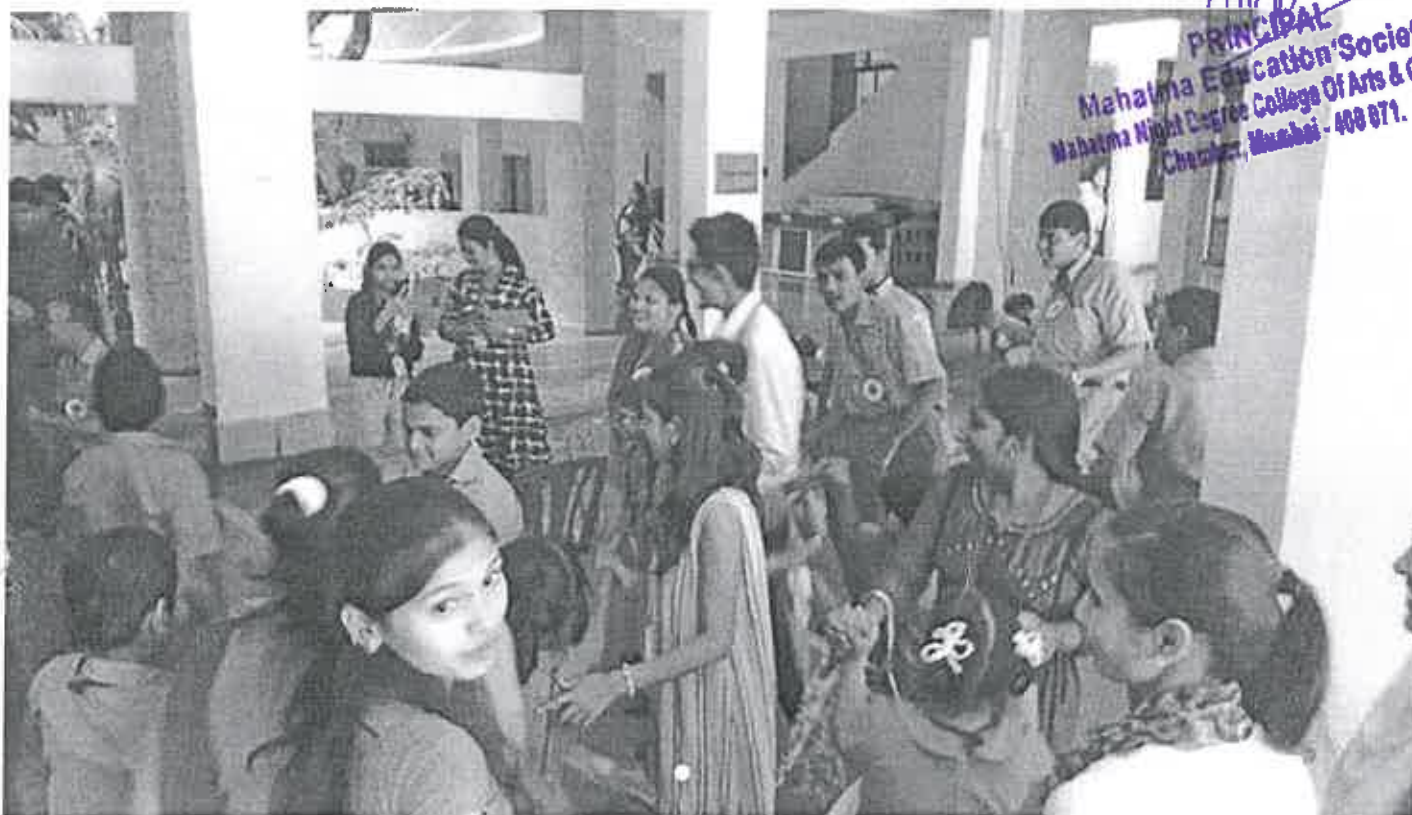
