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


Brief Report of the Program:-

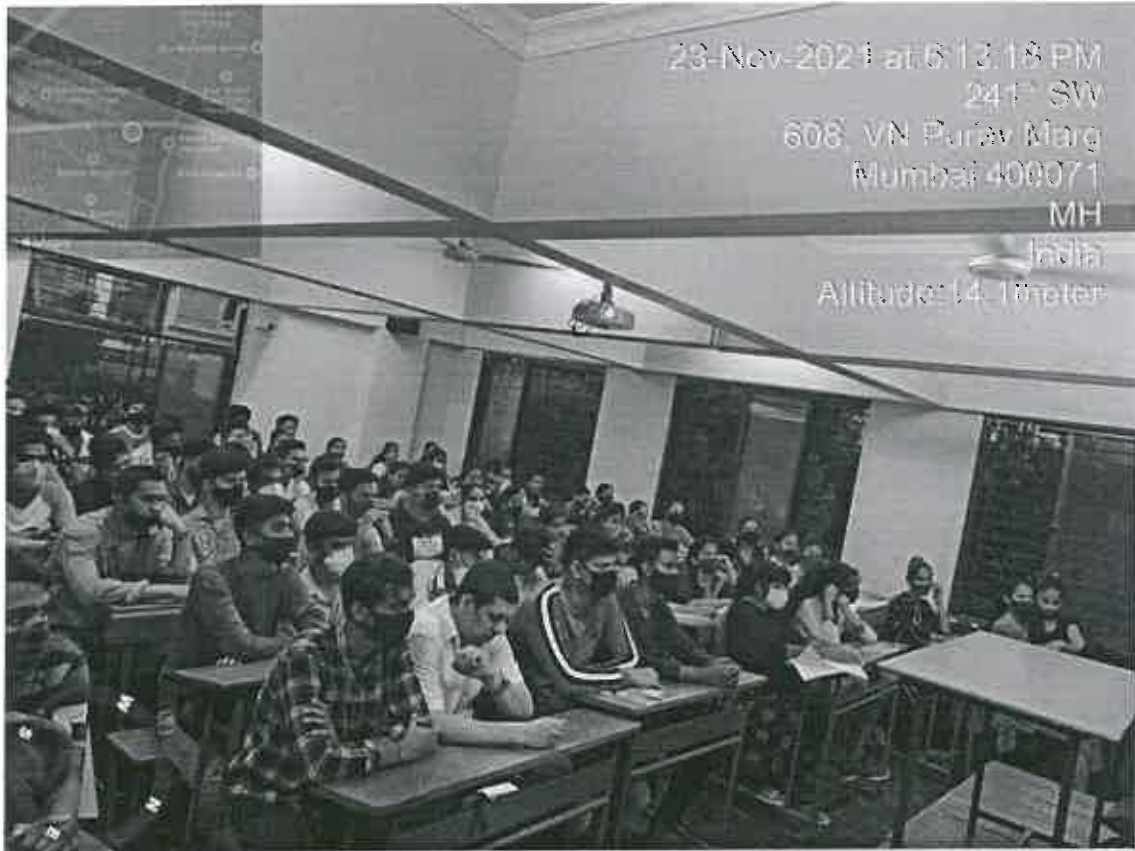
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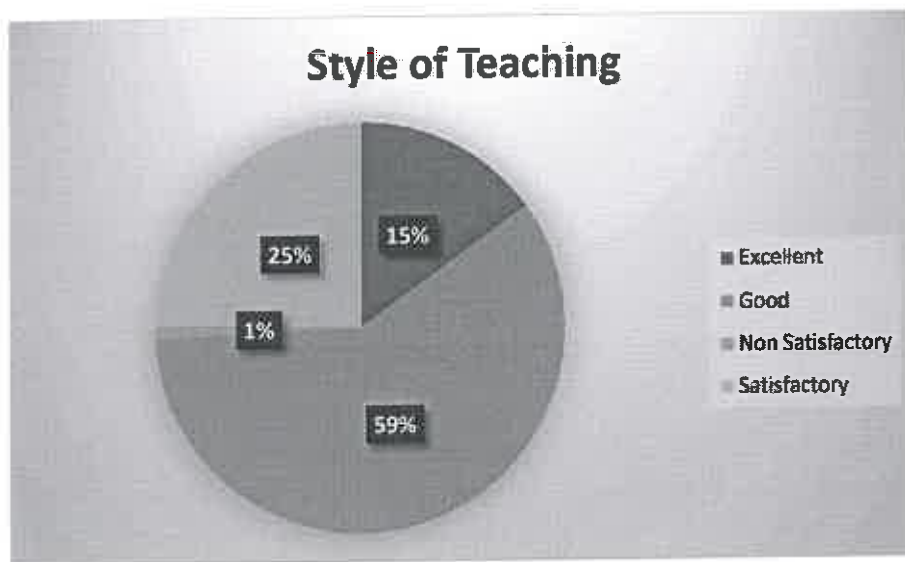
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Feedback For Student Development Program

Figure 1: Style of Teaching

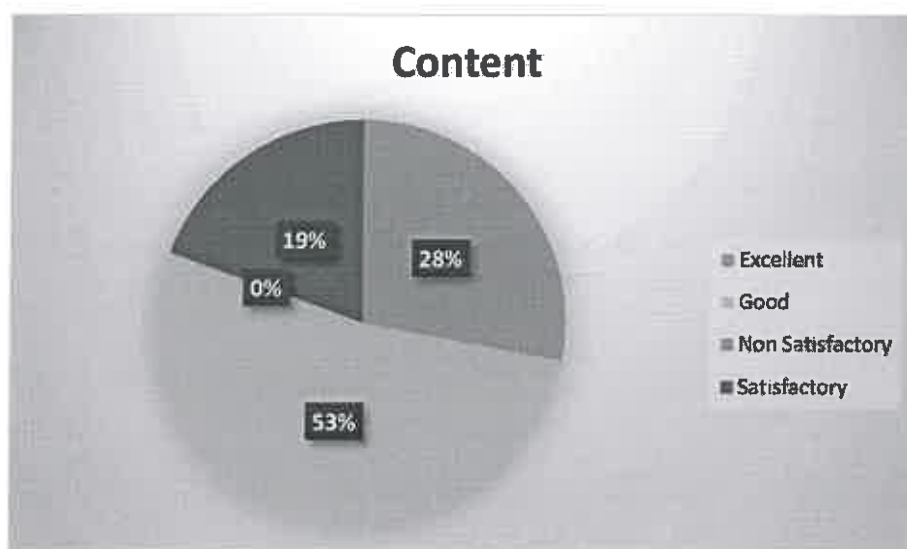

Figure 2: Content of the Lectures

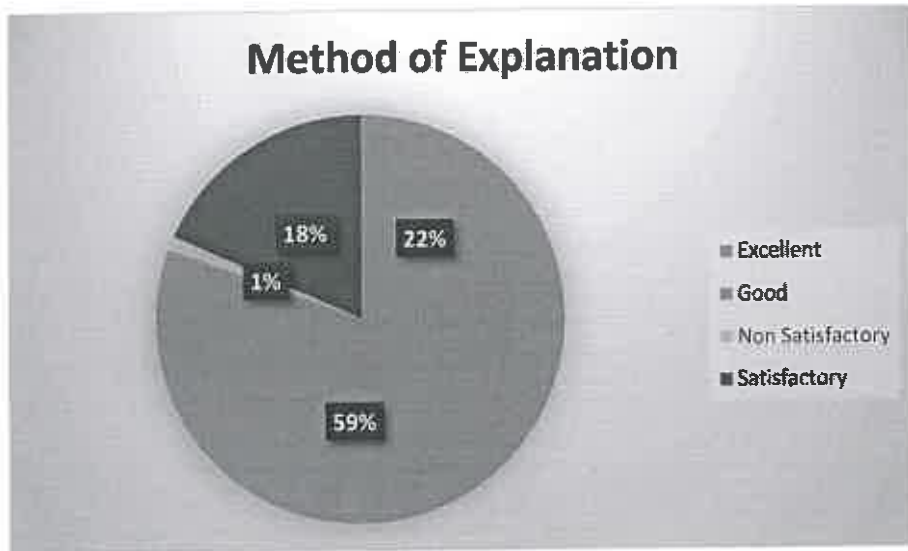

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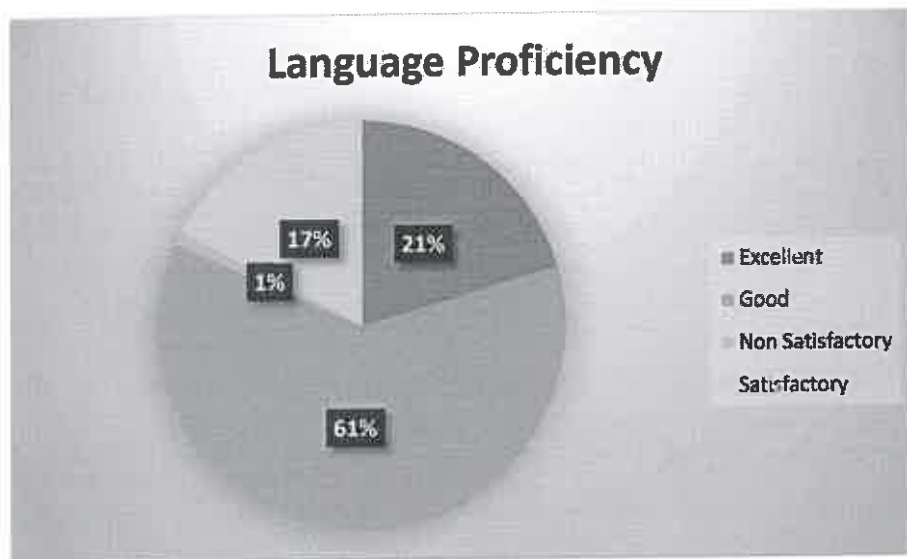
Figure 3: Method of Explanation

Figure 5: Ability to Clear Doubts





This facilitating easy trade for the investor. Demat account holds all the investments in electronic format. It allows to invest in securities, exchange traded funds, bonds and mutual funds in one place.
- Dematerialization is the process of converting the physical share certificate into electronic form, which is also easier to maintain and is safe as it is held in Demat only. Participants (DP) the purpose of dematerialization is to eliminate the need for the investor to hold physical share certificate and applying to transfer, buying and selling of holdings.
